- CANELLA Prosecco Brut** (Veneto, Italy) 5oz 10gl 50bt  
Crisp and dry with white flowers and pear.
- 2018 SEVEN TERRACES Rose of Pinot Noir** (Christchurch, New Zealand) 12gl 51bt  
The Empson family has created a lovely winery just outside of Christchurch. Refreshing with faint strawberry, thyme and soft hibiscus, perfectly primed for summer warmth.
- 2019 BRIGALDARA Garganega Soave** (Veneto, Italy) 11gl 46bt  
One of the classic growing areas of the world. These old volcanic soils allow the Garganega grape to flourish here. This is filled with delicate white flowers, faint nougat and rich apple.
- 2018 TINHORN CREEK Pinot Gris** (Okanagan Valley, Canada) 13gl 55bt  
The darling white grape of the Pacific Northwest. A luscious offering with highlights of pear peel and Gala apple. Very refreshing and perfect for most occasions.
- 2018 KITTEN SWISH Riesling ‘It’s Been Friday For A While’** (Rheingau, Germany) 14gl 59bt  
This tidy, dry and fruity Riesling from the gentle slopes around the town of Hattenheim is designed for refreshment. It gushes with chamomile, lime leaf and cantaloupe rind. When it’s been Friday for a while, you better have a glass of something delicious.
- 2019 ASTROLABE Sauvignon Blanc** (Marlborough, New Zealand) 12gl 51bt  
The Forest-Waghorn family has two generations of winemaking in Marlborough. The name of the winery is coined after an exploratory French ship that sailed around Marlborough in 1827. This is brimming with grapefruit, guava and gooseberry. Quite punchy and full of life.
- 2017 BREWER CLIFTON Chardonnay** (Sta. Rita Hills, United States) 15gl 63bt  
Brewer Clifton is one of California’s best Chardonnay specialists. Beautiful harmony here with sunflower, almond and perfectly ripe Gala apple.

2018 MAS LAS CABES Syrah ~ Grenache (Côtes du Roussillon, France) 11gl 46bt  
Smoked bacon drizzled with blueberry pie filling. Wonderfully aromatic and stylishly elegant.

2016 BIBI GRAETZ Sangiovese Casamatta (Tuscany, Italy) 9gl 38bt  
From one of Tuscany's superstar winemakers. This is super juicy and very versatile. Lovely freshness here with notes of cherry and sage. Casamatta translates as *crazyhouse*.

2018 MEYER FAMILY Pinot Noir (Okanagan Valley, Canada) 15gl 63bt  
JAK Meyer and his team make some of the most sumptuous wines in the country. This is very pretty and quite fresh delivering a seductive nose of cranberry, sage and smashed warm cherry.

2017 CATENA Malbec (Mendoza, Argentina) 10gl 42bt  
This hails from the Catena family, the pioneering family that has brought the world's attention to the choice growing areas of Mendoza. They have through trial isolated the best clones of Malbec for Argentinean soils. A violet scented room, ground potters soil, a mixed bag of black fruits.

2017 PAOLO CONTERNO Nebbiolo d'Alba (Piedmont, Italy) 13gl 55bt  
One of the best value wines from the same area as the famed Barolo and Barbaresco wines, this Nebbiolo is fresh and fragrant with tell-tale rose petal, sweet cherry and market spice tea.

2016 HEDGES Cabernet Sauvignon ~ Merlot ~ Syrah (Washington, United States) 16gl 68bt  
Brambleberry scented ganache with a beautiful swath of tanned leather and cigar wrapper.
